

BREAST CANCER PILLOWCASE PATTERN

<p>Fabric Requirement:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Trim Band—Cut one piece 2 x 22 inches from accent fabric • Cuff—Cut one piece 6 ½ x 22 inches from band fabric • Body—Cut one piece 15 x 22 inches from main fabric 	<p>Assembly:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Press the accent fabric (2 x 22) together lengthwise, wrong sides together • Place band fabric (6 ½ x 22), wrong side down on table • Lay Main fabric (15 x 22) wrong side down on top of band fabric matching top edge • Place accent fabric on top of Main fabric, fold down. • Pin all three layers together • Roll Main fabric in a tube to the accent fabric and bring up Band fabric to meet top edge of all fabrics and pin. • Sew across pinned edges removing pins as you sew. • Now the magic happens—reach inside the tube and pull out Main fabric. Press. • Lay the case so that the side and bottom edges are even and pillowcase is wrong sides together. Trim to make certain all edges are straight. • Stitch from the end and down the side a scant ¼ inch. Trim to 1/8 inch. • Turn the pillowcase in so that it is right sides together. PRESS and stitch against the edge and side seams, a generous ¼ inch seam. • Turn right side out. <p style="text-align: center;">YOUR PILLOWCASE IS DONE!</p>

<p>FABRIC REQUIREMENT:</p> <p style="text-align: center;">15 x 22 Inches white or off white muslin</p> <p>*Pillows will be personally stuffed for each breast cancer patient. The casings for the stuffing would be very much appreciated.</p>	<p>ASSEMBLY:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fold in half to 15 x 11 inches • Sew one side and bottom, turn right side out.
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
